Lesson/Workshop 1 “From problems to solutions”

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Aims of the lesson

In this workshop participants will be invited to identify specific local problems and to offer their feasible plan to solve them, working in teams.



Description

Concrete steps:

1. Introduction: the trainer introduces the workshop and its learning objectives (5')
2. Teams setting and instructions delivery (5')
3. Participants are split into different group (5 per group max) and invited to reflect on their local reality (their neighborhood, their city, or their province) and to point out the main problems of it, using the problem tree model. They are also invited to describe these problems in an accurate and objective way, by searching for and using relevant data (numbers, pictures, etc) (50')
4. Afterwards, each group is invited to transform these problems into feasible objectives and solutions, taking into consideration fundamental assets such as: human and financial resources, time, equipment, etc (40')

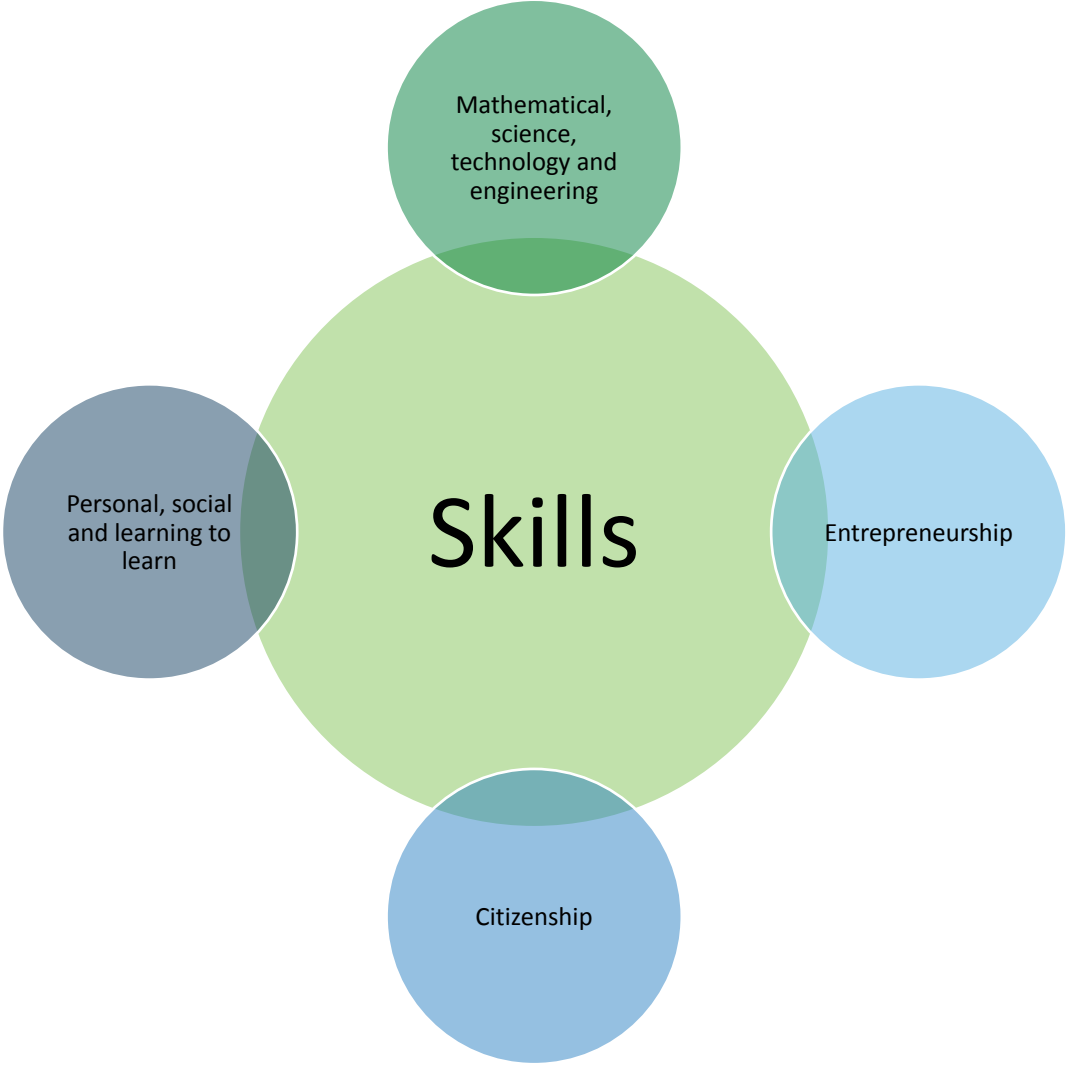
Finally, each group will choose the results of its own work to rest of the classroom and the trainer will stimulate reflections and feedback from all participants (40' if 2 groups, 60' if 3 groups, etc)

- Increasing the basic knowledge on problem analysis
- Increasing the basic knowledge on public administration and finance
- Fostering the following key competences, among others:
 - Mathematical, science, technology and engineering
 - Citizenship
 - Entrepreneurship
 - Personal, social and learning to learn
