## Lesson/Workshop 3 "Digital citizenship: rights on the web"

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#### Aims of the lesson

Through this activity participants will get to know which are their rights on the web and what does "digital citizenship" mean



#### **Description**

#### Concrete steps:

Brief discussion about citizens rights in general

Reading the "Declaration of Rights on the Internet"

Visual representation of the articles of the Declaration: The trainer will divide the group into small groups and will have one member draw a note per group, on which the article number of the Declaration of Rights on the Internet that the group will have to analyze will be reported. Participants will then be invited to read the article entrusted to them, analyze its content and, subsequently, represent it with an image or icon.


Sharing on the need to be protected online: after a moment of sharing the work done, the trainer will ask participants if they ever thought that some issues such as access to the Net, net neutrality, online privacy, anonymity etc., were subject to rights and if they ever felt the need to be protected online.

Conclusions: get a billboard where each group will attach the leaflet with the article and the drawing made: the teacher/trainer will divide the board in half; each group will have to report, next to each other and in their respective columns, the law that they have deepened in depth and the design made.
